PAVERPOL FABRIC BOWL



MATERIALS:

- Paverpol Transparent
- Water
- Measuring cup
- Bowl (no bigger than 25cm)
- Cling wrap
- Fabric strips
- Hairdryer
- Plastic (to dry bowl on)
- Paintbrush
- Stirring stick

METHOD

Add water to Paverpol and stir through with stirring stick (30ml to 1L) Cover bowl with cling wrap twice making sure it's smooth.

Place bowl onto a piece of plastic before you begin.

With the paint brush dab a small amount of Paverpol onto the fabric and

knead it through before placing on bowl. Cover bowl with fabric pieces.

Use a hairdryer to speed up the drying process. When dry remove the bowl and cling wrap.

NOTE: For added strength paint the outside of the bowl again with the paintbrush. Wash hands and paint brush in warm water when finished.

Tip

Have a warm bucket of soapy water with you so you can wash your hands as the Paverpol dries on your hands - otherwise it may come off on the material.

PAVERPOL FABRIC PLACEMATS

MATERIALS

- Paverpol *Transparent*
- Water
- Measuring cup
- Chopping board
- Fabric strips (sewn together)
- Hairdryer
- Plastic (to dry on)
- Paintbrush
- Stirring stick

METHOD

Add water to Paverpol and stir through with stirring stick (30ml to 1L)

Sew fabric strips together until piece is larger than chopping board. Place chopping board onto piece of plastic.

With the paint brush dab Paverpol onto the back of the fabric and knead it through before placing on board. Making sure the piece of fabric is



completely covered in Paverpol.

Use a hairdryer to speed up the drying process. When dry, paint on top

of the fabric again for finishing.

NOTE: Wash hands and paint brush in warm water when finished.
